

Junior, Intermediate, Senior & Open Competitions, to be held under the British Isles Shearing Competition Association (BISCA) Rules on Saturday 6th September 2025

RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. The decision of the Judge is final.
- 2. Shearing will be held under BISCA rules.
- 3. Starting times of classes will vary depending on entries. Please arrive 30 minutes before your class is scheduled to start.
- 4. Competitors are responsible for using safe working practices and using appropriate safety wear. Competitors must comply with the latest Health & Safety guidance relating to animal handling, as well as relevant legislation.
- 5. Shearing equipment will be loaned by *Lister Shearing Equipment Ltd.* All solid drives will be fitted with worm drive ends.
- 6. Shearers are only eligible to enter in one group above their classification.
- 7. The judges will inspect each shearer's sheep individually in the pen once shorn.
- 8. Any spare unshorn sheep will be shorn by the competitors before the last competition of the day.
- 9. Anyone making equipment unsafe, or supplying and using their own grinder, will be instantly disqualified.
- 10. Prize money. Winning competitors will receive a prize money voucher which can be redeemed at the Show, please see instructions on the prize money card.
- 11. One vehicle pass will be issued per exhibitor. Additional tickets can be purchased from Showing Scene at the advance price or on the day at the Show Day price.
- 12. The Best Local Shearer will be decided by the local shearer with the best pen of sheep in the heats. A copy of the Moreton Show boundary map is available on request.
- 13. Semi-Finals will only be held where justified by the number of entries.
- 14. The Moreton in Marsh & District Agricultural & Horse Show Society reserve right to amend or cancel any of the foregoing regulations.

REGULATIONS:

In addition to the regulations outlined above, please note that all matters of general application (e.g. appointment of judges, etc) are covered in the Moreton Show General Showing Rules which can be found on the Moreton Show website.

The following recommendations are made by the BISCA Committee:

All Junior & Intermediate Shearers should be encouraged to inspect their shorn sheep immediately after finishing their heat where expert advice can be given by both judges

Where competitors are allowed to shear up a class, only Juniors that have qualified through from the Junior heats should be allowed to shear in the Intermediate class.

Any conduct that is detrimental to the ethics of BISCA by either competitor or official shall be notified to the Disciplinary Committee:

The Disciplinary Committee has the right to suspend, for a period, or remove any miscreant from their respective list.

The decision of the Committee is FINAL.

Appeals have to be submitted in writing, to the referee 15 minutes after the occurrence with the lodgement fee of £20, returnable if upheld.
